23 and police civil service employees in which shall be set forth the name of each employee,
24 the class title of position held, the salary or other compensation, any change in class title, and
25 any other necessary data.

26 ~~(5)~~ (e) Assist and cooperate in an advisory manner with the various appointing
27 authorities, department officers, and the classified employees of the municipalities regarding
28 the duties and obligations imposed upon them by the provisions of this Part.

29 ~~(6)~~ (f) Encourage employee training in the classified service and, when possible,
30 attend the training courses or parts thereof.
