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Prohibits the sale of electronic cigarettes and vapor products to persons under the age of eighteen

Present law prohibits the distribution of sample tobacco products to persons under the age of 18 years. Proposed law adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the present law prohibition. Defines alternative nicotine product and vapor product. Present law provides in order to prevent persons under the age of 18 years of age from purchasing or receiving tobacco products from vending machines or self-service displays, the sale or delivery of tobacco products through a vending machine or self-service display is prohibited. Proposed law adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the present law prohibitions. Present law provides that the sale of tobacco products to a minor by a retail dealer's agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant is considered an act of the retail dealer except under certain circumstances. Proposed law adds alternative nicotine products and vapor products to the coverage of present law. Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
