**SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original Senate Bill No. 661 by Senator Erdey

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, after "**vehicle**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 9 in its  
3 entirety and insert the following:

4 **"crash or incident, any police officer or any person acting"**

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 10, change "**their**" to "**the officer's**" and after "**request**" delete the comma  
7 " , "

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 12, change "**within the highway**" to "**upon the roadway or shoulder of the**  
10 **roadway**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, line 14, change "**accident**" to "**crash**"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, line 15, change "**accident**" to "**crash**"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 1, delete lines 16 and 17 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

17 **"traffic hours, any police officer or any person acting at the officer's direction**  
18 **or request shall take immediate"**

19 AMENDMENT NO. 7

20 On page 2, line 2, between "**public**" and the period " ." insert the following:

21 **"provided such action does not impair the protection of public safety"**

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 2, delete lines 5 through 7 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

24 **"C. No liability shall attach to any police officer or to any person acting**  
25 **under the officer's direction or request for damages to a vehicle, cargo, or other**  
26 **personal property, that"**

27 AMENDMENT NO. 9

28 On page 2, below line 9 add the following:

29 **"D. The provisions of this Section apply only to roadways included within**  
30 **the National Highway System in this state."**
