CLERKS OF COURT: Provides relative to group insurance expenses of the clerks of court in certain parishes

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:783(F)(7), relative to the payment of group insurance 3 premium costs for certain clerk of court employees; to require the clerks of court for 4 Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish, and Webster Parish to pay certain group insurance 5 premium costs; to provide for eligibility for payment of such costs; and to provide 6 for related matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. 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court's office, or the Winn Parish clerk of court's office who is entitled to receive monthly benefits from the Louisiana Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund, who has at least twenty years of full-time service with the clerk of court's office in Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish, Caldwell Parish, Franklin Parish, Grant Parish, LaSalle Parish, Webster Parish, or Winn Parish, and who is at least fifty-five years of age. The provisions of this Paragraph shall not apply to any other insurance, such as supplemental insurance, that an employee may elect to purchase.

**Abstract:** Provides for eligibility for payment of group insurance premium costs for employees retiring from certain clerks of court offices.

<u>Present law</u> requires the premium costs of group life and accidental death and dismemberment, group health, accident, dental, hospital, surgical, or other medical expense insurance to be paid in full by the clerk of court for the parishes of Caldwell, Franklin, Grant, LaSalle, and Winn from the clerk's salary fund for any employee who is entitled to receive monthly benefits from the La. Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund and who retires with at least 20 years of full-time service and is at least 55 years of age.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and extends requirements relative to the payment of group insurance premium costs to the clerk's of court for the parishes of Bossier, Caddo, and Webster.
