
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 380 by Representative Geymann

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "students" delete the semi-colon ";" and delete the remainder of the
3 line and insert "unless certain conditions are met; to provide for exceptions; to provide for
4 an effective date; and to"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 11, after "consortium" insert a comma "," and delete the remainder of the
7 line and delete line 12 in its entirety and insert the following:

8 "if the implementation or administration is through a contract or agreement that did not
9 utilize a request for proposals process as provided in this Title, unless the expenditure of
10 such funds is approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. The provisions
11 of this Section shall not apply to a college entrance examination including the American
12 College Test and the Scholastic Aptitude Test, a high school equivalency examination, or
13 an industry-based certification examination."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 3

15 On page 1, after line 12, insert the following:

16 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
17 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
18 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
19 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
20 effective on the day following such approval."
