In addition, a 18 matter intended to have the effect of law, including a measure proposing a 19 suspension of law, which is not within the subject matter restrictions 20 21 provided in this Subparagraph may be considered at any such session if:

(i) It is prefiled no later than the deadline provided in Subparagraph
(2) of this Paragraph, provided that the member shall not prefile more than
five two such matters pursuant to this Subsubparagraph; or

"Do you support an amendment to reduce from five to two the number of
prefiled bills that a legislator may introduce in a regular session convening
in an odd-numbered year that are exceptions to the subject matter limitations
for such sessions, to delay the date of convening for such sessions by two
weeks, and to reduce from sixty to fifty the maximum number of calendar
days for such sessions? (Amends Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(a) and (b)(i))"
