HOUSE BILL NO. 1244

AIRCRAFT/AIRPORTS: Repeals the Southeast Regional Airport Authority

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal Chapter 6 of Title 2 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S.
3 2:701 through 710, relative to the Southeast Regional Airport Authority; to repeal
4 the creation and authority of the entity; and to provide an effective date.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Chapter 6 of Title 2 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised
7 of R.S. 2:701 through 710, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

8 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature of this Act by the
9 governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become
10 law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
11 Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved
12 by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Repeals provisions of law that create the Southeast Regional Airport Authority and provide for the powers, duties, and procedures of the authority.

Present law creates the Southeast Regional Airport Authority as a body politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the state. Authorizes the authority to exercise such powers as necessary or convenient to carry out its purpose.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
