
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Original House Bill No. 150 by Representative Gisclair

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 3 through 5
3 in their entirety, and insert the following:

4 "R.S. 32:58 and to enact R.S. 32:414(W), relative to careless operation of a
5 motor vehicle; to provide relative to the prohibition on careless operation of
6 a motor vehicle when the operator fails to maintain control of the vehicle by
7 falling asleep; to provide for penalties relative to violations of such
8 prohibitions; to provide for the suspension of driving privileges; and to
9 provide for"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

11 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 19 in their entirety, on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 in
12 their entirety, and insert the following:

13 "Section 1. R.S. 32:58 is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
14 32:414(W) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

15 §58. Careless operation

16 A. Any person operating a motor vehicle on the public roads of this
17 state shall drive in a careful and prudent manner, so as not to endanger the
18 life, limb, or property of any person. Failure to drive in such a manner shall
19 constitute careless operation.

20 B. If the careless operation of the motor vehicle directly or
21 proximately causes the death of a human being, when the operator fails to
22 maintain control of the vehicle by falling asleep, in addition to any penalties
23 provided by the provision of this Title, the person shall also be ordered to
24 serve court-approved community service for not more than two hundred fifty
25 hours and the department shall suspend the operator's license for a period of
26 two years.

28 AMENDMENT NO. 3

29 On page 2, line 9, after "upon" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 10 in its entirety,
30 and insert the following:

31 "receiving satisfactory evidence of a conviction, plea of guilty, or plea of
32 nolo contendere for a violation of R.S. 32:58 when the operator fails to
33 maintain control of the vehicle by falling asleep and when such operation
34 directly or proximately causes the death of a human being."
