Kostelka SB No. 624

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the governing authority of any municipality having a population between 12,850 and 13,075 to levy a sales tax of up to 1% if approved by the electors of the municipality.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs</u> to the <u>engrossed</u> bill.

1. Changes the maximum population of municipalities to which the bill is applicable <u>from</u> 13,250 <u>to</u> 13,075.
