1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, delete lines 12 through 20, in their entirety, and on page 2, delete lines 1 through
15, in their entirety, and insert:

4 "A. The provisions of this Part shall not apply to gratuitous care provided by 5 friends or members of the individual's family. The provisions of this Part shall apply 6 to all direct service workers employed by a licensed agency, or employed as part of 7 an authorized departmental self-directed program, and who attend to individuals 8 receiving home- and community-based long-term services and who are not 9 authorized to perform these tasks under other state laws or regulations. An 10 individual being served shall meet the following criteria:

(1) Is eligible for home- and community-based long-term care services
 licensed by the Department of Health and Hospitals.

(2) Is able to self-direct the services or resides <u>Resides</u> in a residence where
 there is daily monitoring by a family member, a direct service worker, or other health
 care provider.

(3) Has a current plan of care.

17 (4) Receives a periodic assessment by a registered nurse based on the18 individual's health status.

- 19 (5) Requires assistance with medication administration or other noncomplex
 20 medical tasks."

23 "or employed as part of an authorized departmental self-directed program"

27 directed program, the training he will receive shall be developed by the Department of
