1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, change "to authorize" to "to require"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, after "certain" delete "abandoned"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 4, change "lower ninth ward;" to "Lower Ninth Ward for a specified price  
7 under certain circumstances;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 6, change "authorization;" to "requirement;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, line 10, delete "ABANDONED"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 1, line 11, delete "abandoned"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 1, delete line 13, and insert "Louisiana, the city of New Orleans shall sell vacant  
16 lots that are located in the Lower Ninth Ward and that were acquired through the Louisiana  
17 Road Home program and that are either owned by the New Orleans Redevelopment  
18 Authority or the authority has been tasked with management and disposition of the property  
19 for"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 19 and insert the following:

22 "(2) Property shall be sold pursuant to this Section only to a  
23 purchaser who meets either of the following criteria:

24 (a) He is qualified under the Lot Next Door program or any similar  
25 program which authorizes the sale of property to adjacent property owners.

26 (b) He agrees to build a residence on the property and to reside at  
27 that residence.

28 (3) The governing authority of the city of New Orleans shall  
29 establish rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this  
30 Section."
