



1 urge and request the Louisiana High School Athletic Association to study current practices  
2 of its member high schools regarding the awarding of athletic letters, jackets, patches, and  
3 other indicia to student athletes.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such study shall include determining the  
5 feasibility of establishing a uniform policy to govern the awarding of athletic letters and  
6 related jackets, patches, and other indicia in recognition of team participation to be followed  
7 by all member schools, including a requirement that a student athlete who has been a  
8 member of a team for at least three years during high school shall automatically be eligible  
9 to be awarded an athletic letter for the sport in which he participated and to receive any  
10 related letters, jackets, patches, and other indicia.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
12 executive director of the Louisiana High School Athletic Association.
