Amedee (SB 303)

Present law provides certain exceptions to the Code of Governmental Ethics.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds an exception to the Code of Governmental Ethics to permit the employment of a person by a board that is created by law when the person has served as a member of the board as a designee, as authorized by law, of a mayor of a municipality with a population of three hundred thousand or more according to the latest decennial census.
