

1 Highway 22 toward Louisiana Highway 70 and making left turns, resulting in vehicles that
2 continue traveling on Louisiana Highway 22 to cross the Sunshine Bridge driving upon the
3 shoulder to proceed past stopped, left-turning vehicles; and

4 WHEREAS, there is a neutral ground on Louisiana Highway 22 that may allow for
5 construction of turn lanes or three-lanes; and

6 WHEREAS, the department needs to take action to provide greater safety to the
7 motoring public, to move traffic more efficiently, and to minimize traffic accidents at the
8 intersection of Cornerview Road and Louisiana Highway 73 and on Louisiana Highway 22
9 between Interstate Highway 10 and Louisiana Highway 70 in Ascension Parish.

10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
11 request the Department of Transportation and Development to take action to provide greater
12 safety to the motoring public, to move traffic more efficiently, and to minimize traffic
13 accidents at the intersection of Cornerview Road and Louisiana Highway 73 and on
14 Louisiana Highway 22 between Interstate Highway 10 and Louisiana Highway 70 in
15 Ascension Parish.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
17 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
