 - (b) The subpoena is limited in scope to a request for the dispenser information submitted to the board pursuant to R.S. 40:1006.
 - (2) A party to a proceeding for custody or visitation of a child may petition the court for, or the court on its own motion may issue, an order for an in camera inspection by the court of prescription monitoring information related to an individual who is a party to the proceeding. The petition shall be filed in the form of a rule to show cause and shall allege facts showing that the prescription monitoring information relates to an individual who is a party to the proceeding for custody or visitation of a child and the requested information has a substantial bearing on the fitness of that individual. The court may order production and disclosure of the prescription monitoring information for in camera inspection as the court deems appropriate."
