25 lines, in the coastal zone in the future.

27 and encouraged to assist, as requested by the commissioner or the secretary, in
28 conducting the comprehensive assessment and evaluation, specifically including the
29 attorney general to evaluate and assess the legal and regulatory authorities of the
30 commissioner, the secretary, and other relevant state and federal agencies."
