Provides for court-ordered criminal background checks in connection with certain adoptions and provides for the petition for intrafamily adoptions

Present law (Ch.C. Art. 1243) specifies that a stepparent, step-grandparent, great grandparent, grandparent, or collaterals (brother, sister, aunt, uncle, nephew, niece, or cousin) within the 12th degree that is related through a child parent's having parental rights may petition for an intrafamily adoption. Proposed law retains present law but changes the requirement that the petitioner be related to the child's mother or father who is filated (paternity has been determine judicially) to the child. Proposed law repeals the definition of a "parent recognized as having parental rights".
