DIGEST

Amedee (SB 303)

Present law provides certain exceptions to the Code of Governmental Ethics.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds an exception to the Code of Governmental Ethics to permit the employment of a person by a board that is created by law when the person has served as a member of the board as a designee, as authorized by law but not subject to confirmation nor confirmed by the council of the municipality, of a mayor of a municipality with a population of three hundred thousand or more according to the latest federal decennial census.

Effective August 1, 2014.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental</u> Affairs to the original bill

1. Adds an exception to the Code of Governmental Ethics to permit the employment of a person by a board that is created by law when the person has served as a member of the board as a designee, as authorized by law, of a mayor of a municipality with a population of three hundred thousand or more according to the latest decennial census.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

- 1. Specifies that the mayor's designee is not subject to confirmation nor confirmed by the council of the municipality.
- 2. Specifies that the latest decennial census is a federal census.
