3 of the child should be allowed an exception to the established prescriptive periods, and make
4 specific recommendations for revisions to Louisiana law if necessary.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute report its
6 findings and recommendations to the Legislature of Louisiana at least thirty days prior to the
7 convening of the 2015 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
9 director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.
