2	To amend and reenact the introductory paragraph of R.S. 13:841(A) and (2)(c) and (d),
3	relative to miscellaneous fees in civil matters; to provide for setting limits on fees
4	and establishing procedures for the receipt or issuance of certain documents by
5	electronic means; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 13:841(A) and (2)(c) and (d) are
8	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§841. Enumeration of fees in civil matters; miscellaneous
10	A. The clerks of the several district courts may be entitled to demand and
11	receive fees of office, which fees may be less than, but shall not exceed, the
12	following amounts: set forth in this Section. Any clerk of court that establishes
13	procedures for the filing, receipt, or issuance of any of the following documents
14	by electronic means shall establish fees for the filing, receipt, or issuance of
15	electronic documents that shall not exceed the fee that would apply if the
16	document was received, filed, or issued in paper.

20	(c) Paper-exhibits, attachments, transcripts, and depositions-per page, two
21	dollars Exhibits up to eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches, including but
22	not limited to attachments, transcripts, and depositions, two dollars per page.
23	(d) All other exhibits, five dollars All paper exhibits larger than eight and
24	one-half inches by fourteen inches, five dollars per page and all other exhibits,
