KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

TAX/SALES. Authorizes certain municipalities, by population, to levy a sales tax not to exceed one percent. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Reduces the maximum population of municipalities to which the bill applies from 13,250 to 13,075.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Kostelka SB No. 624

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the governing authority of any municipality having a population between 12,850 and 13,075, according to the latest federal decennial census, to levy a sales tax of up to 1% if approved by the electors of the municipality.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
