 \$2256. Benefits; refund of contributions, application, and payment
 A.(1) Any member of this system who has been a member for at least one

year and who meets any of the following shall be entitled to retire from service:

(a) who The member has completed at least twenty-five years of creditable service, who has been a member of this system for at least one year, regardless of age, or.

- (b) any The member who has completed at least twenty years of creditable service, who has been a member of this system for at least one year, and who has attained the age of fifty years,
- (c) or any The member who has completed at least twelve years of service, who has been a member of this system for at least one year, and who has attained the age of fifty-five shall be entitled to retire from service.
- (2) <u>Deferred retirement.</u> Any member who has <u>been a member for at</u> <u>least one year and who meets one of the following shall be entitled to a deferred retirement benefit as indicated:</u>

1	(a) Any member who has completed twenty or more years of creditable
1 2	service, and at least one year of which shall be as a member of this system, and who

	leaves employment covered by this system before attaining age fifty shall be entitled
4	to a retirement benefit beginning at age fifty.
5	(b) Any member who has completed twelve years of creditable service, and
6	at least one year of which shall be as a member of this system, and who leaves
7	employment covered by this system before attaining age fifty-five shall be entitled
8	to a retirement benefit beginning at age fifty-five.

10	(4) Upon such retirement, the member shall be paid an annual retirement
11	allowance, as follows:
12	(a) For any member whose first date of employment occurred on or
13	before June 30, 2014, the retirement allowance shall equal to three and one-third
14	percent of his average final compensation multiplied by his total years of creditable
15	service. The provisions of this Subparagraph shall also apply to any member
16	whose first date of employment occurred on or after July 1, 2014, if such
17	member is approved for disability benefits for an injury sustained in the line of
18	duty or if such member is killed in the line of duty, and if the applicable law
19	provides for the calculation of disability or survivor benefits based on a benefit
20	accrual rate.

	after July 1, 2014, the retirement allowance shall equal the following:

23	(i) Three percent of the member's average final compensation multiplied
24	by his total years of creditable service if the member has less than thirty years

29	(c) However, the annual retirement allowance shall not exceed one hundred
30	percent of his the member's average final compensation. The member shall not be
31	paid any amount in excess of the maximum amount permitted under Section 415 of
32	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The foregoing sentence shall no
33	prohibit payments to a member from an excess benefit plan established pursuant to
34	Section 415(m) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, as provided in
35	Section 2272 of this Chapter.
