
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to Original Senate Resolution No. 150 by Senator Morrell

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

3 "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall also have
4 the following ex officio, nonvoting members:

- 5 (1) The president of the Pelican Institute for Public Policy, or his
6 designee.
7 (2) The executive director of the Micah Project, or his designee.
8 (3) The secretary of the Department of Children and Family
9 Services, or her designee.
10 (4) The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and
11 Corrections, Correction Services, or his designee.
12 (5) The chairman of the Louisiana Sentencing Commission, or
13 his designee.
14 (6) The executive director of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association,
15 or his designee.
16 (7) The executive director of Families and Friends of Louisiana's
17 Incarcerated Children, or her designee.
18 (8) The deputy secretary of the office of juvenile justice, or her
19 designee.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall be chaired
21 by the chairman of the Senate Committee on Judiciary B and be staffed by
22 the staff of the Senate."

23 AMENDMENT NO. 2

24 On page 2, after line 20, insert the following:

25 "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be
26 transmitted to the following departments and organizations: the Pelican
27 Institute for Public Policy; the Micah Project; the Department of Children
28 and Family Services; the Department of Public Safety Services and
29 Corrections, Correction Services; the Louisiana Sentencing Commission; the
30 Louisiana Sheriffs' Association; Family and Friends of Louisiana's
31 Incarcerated Children; and, the office of juvenile justice."
