1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact Children's Code Articles 633, 748, 844 and 1018, relative to petitions  
3 in certain proceedings; to remove the requirement of verification of such petitions;  
4 to provide for certain terms, conditions and procedures; and to provide for related  
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. Children's Code Articles 633, 748, 844 and 1018 are hereby amended and  
8 reenacted to read as follows:

9 Art. 633. Form of petition

10 A. The petition shall contain a caption setting forth the name of the court and  
11 the title of the action. The petition shall be entitled, "The State of Louisiana in the  
12 Interest of . . ."

13 B. Allegations of fact shall be simple, concise, and direct and shall be set  
14 forth in numbered paragraphs. As far as practicable, each paragraph shall be limited  
15 to a single set of circumstances.

16 ~~C. The petition shall be verified.~~ Allegations of fact may be made on  
17 information and belief.

18 ~~D.C.~~ Failure to comply with formal requirements of this Article shall not be  
19 grounds for dismissal of a petition or invalidation of the proceedings unless it results  
20 in substantial prejudice.

22 Art. 748. Form of petition

23 A. The petition shall contain a caption setting forth the name of the court and
