5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:383.3 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§383.3. Municipal governing authorities; limitation of terms of elected
8	officials; referendum
9	The governing authority of a municipality having a population between
10	two thousand five hundred and five thousand within a parish having a
11	population between two hundred thousand and two hundred fifty thousand,
12	based on the latest federal decennial census, may enact an ordinance limiting
13	the number of terms of office which any elected official of the municipality may
14	serve to two consecutive terms in the same office. Any ordinance herein
15	authorized shall become effective only after the question of such term limitation
16	has been submitted to and approved by a majority of the qualified electors of
17	the municipality who vote on the proposition at a regularly scheduled primary
18	or general election held in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code.
19	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
20	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
21	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
