 Provides for information included in the executive budget and the General Appropriation Bill

Proposed bill requires the General Appropriations Bill to include expenditure categories itemized by category for each agency as recommended for the ensuing fiscal year in the supporting document and excludes Higher Education and LSU HSCD from the itemized expenditure category requirements. Proposed bill deletes the requirement that performance data be included in the General Appropriation Act and Ancillary Appropriation Act and be included in either the executive budget or supporting document. Effective July 1, 2014

This bill also transfers performance indicator information (key objectives/key indicators) from the appropriations bill to the governor's executive budget or supporting document. In addition, this bill requires expenditure category information be presented in the appropriations bill.
