HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 1095 by Representative Fannin

APPROPRIATIONS: Appropriates funds for the expenses of the Louisiana Judiciary for Fiscal Year 2014-2015

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds \$8 million in State General Fund (Direct) by reducing the reduction to be implemented pursuant to a plan adopted by the Judicial Budgetary Control Board from \$11.1 million to \$3.1 million.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates funds for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 for the ordinary operating expenses of the judicial branch of government with total funding of \$175,998,230 from the following sources: \$155,338,908 out of the State General Fund (Direct); \$10,436,500 through interagency transfers from the Dept. of Children and Family Services; and \$10,222,822 from statutory dedications out of the Judges' Supplemental Compensation Fund and the Trial Court Case Management Fund.

Provides that the appropriations out of the State General Fund (Direct) contained in this Act shall be reduced by a total amount of \$3,116,190 pursuant to a plan adopted by the Judicial Budgetary Control Board or as approved by the La. Supreme Court.
