White (SB 313) Act No. 300

<u>Prior law</u> defined and provided penalties for the crime of home invasion.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that whoever commits the crime of home invasion armed with a dangerous weapon is to be fined up to \$7,000 and imprisoned at hard labor for up to 30 years.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds that whoever commits the crime of home invasion armed with a dangerous weapon is to be imprisoned for a minimum of five years. <u>New law</u> otherwise retains <u>prior law</u>.

Effective upon signature of the governor (May 28, 2014).
