1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 17:419.3, relative to school support personnel; to provide with respect to 3 compensation for school support personnel who serve as substitute teachers; and to 4 provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 17:419.3 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 <u>§419.3.</u> Compensation for school support employees serving as substitute teachers 8 A. A school support employee shall be compensated at a rate not less than 9 that of a substitute teacher for all work performed as a substitute teacher. 10 Compensation for such work shall not be considered an increase in base salary and 11 shall not be considered in the calculation of the employee's salary in the following 12 school year. The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to any day on which 13 the school support employee performs work as a substitute teacher for less than a 14 single class period. 15 B. Each city, parish, and other local public school board shall establish a policy which provides a standardized method for school support personnel to report 16 17 work performed as a substitute teacher.
