Provides relative to high school core curriculum requirements with respect to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS)

For students who enter the ninth grade on or after July 1, 2014, proposed law states that the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) high school instructional requirements allow Civics to be substituted for one of the following: Government, AP US Government and Politics: Comparative, or AP US Government and Politics: United States. Furthermore, the substituted course shall satisfy the Civics and Free Enterprise instruction as prerequisites to graduation. For students graduating from high school in the 2017-18 school year and thereafter, the proposed legislation makes the following changes to the TOPS core curriculum requirements for Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards: 1. Removes the TOPS core requirement to take one-half unit in Economics, AP Macroeconomics, or AP Microeconomics. 2. Increases the Government/Politics requirement from one-half unit to one unit and adds Civics as a course choice. 3. Adds Economics, AP Macroeconomics, or AP Microeconomics to the course choices for the two units required related to History, Geography, Religion, and Economics.
