General powers, duties, and functions of college and university 8 postsecondary education management boards 9 10 A. Subject only to the powers of the Board of Regents specifically enumerated in Article VIII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and as 11 12 otherwise provided by law, each postsecondary system management board as a body 13 corporate shall have authority to exercise power necessary to supervise and manage 14 the day-to-day operations of institutions of postsecondary education under its control, including but not limited to the following: 15 * 16 17 (3)(a) Receive and expend or allocate for expenditure to the institutions under 18 its jurisdiction all monies appropriated or otherwise made available for purposes of 19 the board or the institutions under its jurisdiction according to the master plan for 20 higher postsecondary education, the funding formula adopted by the Board of 21 Regents, and, except as otherwise provided in the general or a supplemental 22 appropriations bill, the Board of Regents' budget recommendations. 23 (b)(i) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this 24 Paragraph, each board may redirect an amount not to exceed five percent of the 25 allocation specified by the formula for each institution under its control to 26 address specific issues that might arise during the budget allocation process.
