6	provide for application; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 15:541(12)(d) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
9	15:541(12)(e) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§541. Definitions
11	For the purposes of this Chapter, the definitions of terms in this Section shall
12	apply:

14	(12) "Criminal offense against a victim who is a minor" for the purposes of
15	this Chapter means conviction for the perpetration or attempted perpetration of or
16	conspiracy to commit any of the following offenses:
17	* * *
18	(d) A felony violation of R.S. 14:40.2, punishable by imprisonment at hard
19	labor, when the victim is under the age of eighteen, unless either of the following are
20	applicable:
21	(i) The defendant is the parent of the victim.
22	(ii) The defendant is not more than four years older than the victim and is
23	convicted under Subparagraph R.S. 14:40.2(B)(1)(b).

1 (e) Any conviction for an offense under the laws of another state, or military, 2 territorial, foreign, tribal, or federal law which is equivalent to the offenses listed in 3 Subparagraphs (a), (b), and (c) through (d) of this Paragraph. 4 5 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to any person who is convicted or who is in the custody or under the supervision of the Department of Public Safety and 6 7 Corrections on or after the effective date of this Act.
