1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 17:3167.1, relative to the articulation and transfer of academic credit hours
3	across all public educational institutions in Louisiana; to require secondary and
4	postsecondary education management boards to participate in regular meetings
5	regarding articulation and transfer policies and agreements; to provide relative to the
6	purpose and outcomes of such meetings; to provide for reporting; and to provide for
7	related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 17:3167.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§3167.1. Secondary and postsecondary education boards; consultation and
11	<u>collaboration</u>
12	A. The Board of Regents, the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
13	Education, and the public postsecondary education management boards shall
14	establish a process by which the commissioner of higher education, or his
15	designee, and the state superintendent of education, or his designee, and
16	representatives of each respective board shall meet at least once quarterly, upon
17	the call of the commissioner of higher education, to discuss and make
18	recommendations to the Statewide Articulation and Transfer Council and the
19	Board of Regents on matters including but not limited to the following:
20	(1) The appropriate role and responsibilities of each board in
21	implementing the statewide articulation and transfer policies and agreements
22	required by this Chapter.
23	(2) The status of current and proposed policies, activities, and initiatives
24	designed to promote and facilitate the seamless transfer of academic credits
25	across their respective institutions and systems.
26	(3) Methods to enhance and maximize student knowledge and utilization
27	of articulation and transfer policies and programs to ensure that every student

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1	is provided the most direct and time-efficient pathway to earning a
2	postsecondary degree or credential.
3	(4) Methods to overcome all obstacles and barriers preventing the
4	efficient and effective development and implementation of successful
5	articulation and transfer policies and practices, including any regulatory and
6	statutory changes deemed necessary.
7	B. The commissioner of higher education shall include a summary of the
8	proceedings of all meetings conducted pursuant to this Section, including any
9	recommendations for policy or statutory changes, in the Board of Regents'
