To that end it shall be the duty of the Louisiana State Law Institute: * 17 * * 18 (3) To cooperate with the American Law Institute, the Commissioners for the 19 Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States Uniform Law 20 **<u>Commission</u>**, bar associations and other learned societies and bodies by receiving, 21 considering, and making reports on proposed changes in the law recommended by 22 any such body. * 23 * 24 (10) To make recommendations to the legislature on a biennial basis for 25 the repeal, removal or revision of provisions of law that have been declared 26 unconstitutional by final and definitive court judgment.

3	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
4	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

6	effective on the day following such approval.
