

Requests the House Committee on the Administration of Criminal Justice to evaluate the use of solitary confinement, isolation, closed-cell restriction, and extended lockdown by DPS&C and its effectiveness and impact on housing costs, prison violence, inmate safety, recidivism, and the mental health of the inmate placed in such conditions, to report its findings during a public hearing held no later than Jan. 1, 2016, and to submit its findings and recommendations to the DPS&C and the governor no later than Jan. 4, 2016.
