AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:2218.2(A)(2)(d), relative to supplemental compensation for law enforcement officers; to provide for certain law enforcement officers to receive credit for years of service for purposes of supplemental compensation; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:2218.2(A)(2)(d) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§2218.2. Rate of compensation; prior service; supplemental monthly compensation; police to receive additional compensation

(d) In the event that a P.O.S.T.-certified law enforcement officer employed on a full-time basis by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, the division of probation and parole, or a retired state police officer who receives compensation pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 40:1457, transfers or begins employment with any other law enforcement agency, the officer shall receive credit for prior service with the agencies listed in
