

Existing law provides that no minor may be issued a driver's license or learner's permit for the operation of a motor vehicle unless, at the time of application, documentation is presented to the department that the minor is enrolled and is attending a school as defined herein.

Existing law provides upon request of any minor who is enrolled and attending school and who is eligible to apply for a license, the appropriate authority shall provide to him a documentation form developed by the Dept. of Education and made available to all school boards, home school providers, and adult education supervisors, of his compliance.

New law provides documentation of school attendance provided to the minor by the appropriate authority is valid for a period of 90 days from the date of issuance.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
