DISTRICT ATTORNEYS: Authorizes district attorney investigators to have arrest powers

1 AN ACT 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 16:13.1, relative to district attorneys' investigators; to provide 3 with respect to certain arrest powers; and to provide for related matters. 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 5 Section 1. R.S. 16:13.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 6 §13.1. District attorney's investigator; definition jurisdiction and duties 7 The investigators of the district attorneys' offices shall be peace officers with 8 all privileges, immunities, and defenses accorded to peace officers, except that they 9 shall not have the right to make arrests, except as citizens under Louisiana Code of 10 Criminal Procedure Article 214. They shall have the same territorial jurisdiction as 11 the district attorney for whom they work. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, investigators of a district attorney's office shall not receive state 12 13 supplemental pay.
