Abstract: Establishes the Sickle Cell Patient Navigator Program to be administered by the Dept. of Health and Hospitals under the direction of the La. Sickle Cell Commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the Sickle Cell Patient Navigator Program, referred to hereafter as "the program". Provides that the functions of the program shall include, without limitation, all of the following:

- (1) Training of patient navigators to serve as outreach coordinators, coordinators of family educational sessions, and patient case managers.
- (2) Establishing and strengthening a continuum of care for each sickle cell patient served by the program and for the families of those patients.
- (3) Identifying and contacting sickle cell patients, conducting home visits with patients and their family members, and coordinating patient care.
- (4) Facilitating collaboration among healthcare providers that serve sickle cell patients.
- (5) Delivering public health education on sickle cell disease and treatment.

<u>Proposed law provides</u> that the Dept. of Health and Hospitals shall administer the program under the direction of the La. Sickle Cell Commission. Provides that implementation of <u>proposed law</u> shall be subject to appropriation of funds by the legislature for operation of the program.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the functions of the La. Sickle Cell Commission. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds thereto direction of the Sickle Cell Patient Navigator Program established by <u>proposed law</u> as a function of the commission.
