Abstract: Creates a database to be administered by the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Justice to maintain certain training and hiring information for all law enforcement officers throughout the state.

Proposed law creates the "Louisiana Uniform Law Enforcement Statewide Reporting Database" (database) to be administered by the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Justice (commission) and authorizes the commission to appoint employees, agents, consultants, or special committees to manage the database.

Proposed law requires that the commission be the central depository for all information submitted for the database, and provides for the procedures, powers, and duties of the commission for the creation, operation, maintenance, and use or access to the database.

Proposed law requires the commission to prepare and distribute forms to all law enforcement agencies for reporting information regarding the name, position, certifications related to training and qualifications, and hire and separation from service dates for all law enforcement officers.

Proposed law requires the commission to promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of proposed law.

Proposed law authorizes all law enforcement agencies and institutions to provide the required information in accordance with proposed law and the rules adopted by the commission.
