 Provides relative to the Louisiana Cosmetology Act

Proposed law increases the fee assessed by the LA Board of Cosmetology for examinations, permits, certificates of registration, renewals, and violations by \$10. In addition, the proposed law increases fees associated with cosmetology schools by \$35.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation is anticipated to result in a \$432,205 increase in Fees & Self-Generated Revenue annually as a result of the LA Board of Cosmetology assessing a \$10 increase for examination, permits, certificates, renewals for cosmetology professionals and violations as well as a \$35 increase for renewals of cosmetology schools. The LA Board of Cosmetology issues approximately 38,000 licenses to cosmetologists, estheticians, manicurists, instructors and permits to students. Approximately 5,000 examinations are administered annually. There are 63 cosmetology schools licensed by the board. Based on the number of licenses, examinations and schools, the proposed legislation is projected to increase revenue by \$432,205 (38,000 licenses x \$10 = \$380,000 and 5,000 examinations x 10 = \$50,000 and 63 schools x \$35 = \$2,205).
