  been designated by a parish or a municipal street that been designated by a
  municipality for use by a utility terrain vehicle. Upon a designation that a utility
  terrain vehicle may be operated on a designated road or street, the responsible
  governmental entity shall post appropriate signage indicating that such operation is

- 25 (2) A utility terrain vehicle may cross any divided highway, highway, 26 roadway, or street with a posted speed limit in excess of thirty-five miles per hour
- 27 at an intersection."
