

1 WHEREAS, following the displacement of thousands of residents from the New
2 Orleans area after Hurricane Katrina, East Baton Rouge Parish has experienced an explosive
3 population growth and is now the most populous parish in the state, making the Comite
4 River Diversion Canal Project all the more important and urgently significant.

5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
6 extend the Comite River Diversion Canal Project Task Force to meet and make
7 recommendations to the legislature and the appropriate state and federal agencies on actions
8 necessary to complete the construction and maintenance of the Comite River Diversion
9 Canal Project, including strategies to comply with mitigation requirements and right-of-way
10 acquisitions.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall remain comprised of the
12 following members:

13 (1) One member shall be the member of the House of Representatives appointed
14 by the speaker of the House whose district is directly impacted by the Comite River
15 Diversion Canal Project and who shall be the chairman of the task force.

16 (2) One member shall be the member of the Senate appointed by the president
17 of the Senate whose district is directly impacted by the Comite River Diversion Canal
18 Project and who shall be the vice chairman of the task force.

19 (3) One member shall be appointed by the members of the Louisiana
20 congressional delegation representing the district in which the Comite River Diversion Canal
21 Project is located.

22 (4) One member shall be the district engineer of the U.S. Army Corps of
23 Engineers, New Orleans District, or his designee.

24 (5) One member shall be the secretary of the Department of Transportation and
25 Development, or his designee.

26 (6) One member shall be the executive director of the Coastal Protection and
27 Restoration Authority, or his designee.

28 (7) One member shall be a former member of the Amite River Basin Drainage
29 and Water Conservation District board of commissioners appointed by the chairman of the
30 task force.

1 (8) One member shall be a current member of the Amite River Basin Drainage
2 and Water Conservation District board of commissioners appointed by the chairman of the
3 task force.

4 (9) One member shall be the director of the Department of Public Works of East
5 Baton Rouge Parish, or his designee.

6 (10) One member shall be a home builder within the area impacted by the Comite
7 River Diversion Canal Project appointed by the president of the Louisiana Home Builders
8 Association.

9 (11) One member shall be a realtor in the area impacted by the Comite River
10 Diversion Canal Project appointed by the Louisiana Realtors Association.

11 (12) One member shall be a representative of the Federal Emergency Management
12 Agency (FEMA) appointed by the director of FEMA's Louisiana Recovery Office.

13 (13) One member shall be a landowner in the area impacted by the Comite River
14 Diversion Canal Project appointed by the Louisiana Landowners Association.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall meet at least on a biannual
16 basis and shall submit recommendations to the appropriate legislative committees, as
17 necessary.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this task force will continue to be staffed by the
19 House Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works staff for all meetings of
20 the task force.

Establishes the Comite River Diversion Canal Project Task Force to study and make recommendations to the legislature on actions necessary to complete the construction of the Comite River Diversion Canal Project. Provides that the committee submit a final report to the appropriate legislative committees, as necessary. Provides that the task force will be staffed by the House Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works.

Provides that the task force be composed of the following members:

- (1) One member shall be the member of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker within whose district the Comite River Diversion Canal Project is located and who shall be the chairman of the task force.

- (2) One member shall be the member of the Senate appointed by the president within whose district the Comite River Diversion Canal Project is located and who shall be the vice chairman of the task force.
- (3) One member shall be appointed by the members of the Louisiana congressional delegation representing the district in which the Comite River Diversion Canal Project is located.
- (4) One member shall be the district engineer of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District, or his designee.
- (5) One member shall be the secretary of the Dept. of Transportation and Development, or his designee.
- (6) One member shall be the executive director of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority, or his designee.
- (7) One member shall be a former member of the Amite River Basin board of commissioners appointed by the chairman of the task force.
- (8) One member shall be a current member of the Amite River Basin board of commissioners appointed by the chairman of the task force.
- (9) One member shall be the director of the Dept. of Public Works of East Baton Rouge Parish, or his designee.
- (10) One member shall be a homebuilder within the area impacted by the Comite River Diversion Canal Project appointed by the president of the Louisiana Homebuilder's Association.
- (11) One member shall be a realtor in the area impacted by the Comite River Diversion Canal Project appointed by the Louisiana Realtors Association.
- (12) One member shall be a representative of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) appointed by the director of FEMA's Louisiana Recovery Office.
- (13) One member shall be a landowner in the area impacted by the Comite River Diversion Canal Project appointed by the Louisiana Landowners Association.
