WHEREAS, together she and Leonard settled down in Chauvin and raised their five children: Donna Chabert Malbrough, former Senator Marty J. Chabert, Lori Chabert Blanchard, Lenny Chabert, and Senator Norby Chabert - who claims to be her favorite; and

WHEREAS, Miss Viona supported Leonard in his efforts to attain his graduate equivalency diploma and a degree in education from Nicholls State University on the G.I. Bill; and

WHEREAS, the old saying, "Behind every great man is a great woman" certainly applies to Miss Viona who, as a mother and homemaker, allowed Leonard to pursue his political and business ventures; and

WHEREAS, while she was hesitant about Leonard entering the field of politics, she was his biggest supporter during his public service as justice of the peace, school board member, two-term state representative, three-term state senator, and President Pro-Tempore of the Louisiana Senate; and

WHEREAS, to this day Miss Viona believes in the mission of the Leonard J. Chabert Medical Center to serve the poor and the uninsured people of the bayou region that find themselves in the same position as she and Leonard did growing up and in the early days of their marriage; and

WHEREAS, Miss Viona is the proud grandmother of sixteen, prouder great-grandmother of thirteen, and excited to welcome as many more as the good Lord will bless her with; and

WHEREAS, as the matriarch of the Chabert family, she is beloved, respected, and known up and down the bayou as "Lady Vi"; and

WHEREAS, she is the only lady in Louisiana history to have been married to a state senator and mother to two state senators; and

WHEREAS, Miss Viona is a fine Christian woman and a true Louisiana lady in every sense of the phrase.
