11 (19) The executive director of the Chiropractic Association of Louisiana or
12 his designee.

13 (20) The president of the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy or
14 his designee.

15 (21) The president of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual
16 Physical Therapists or his designee.

17 (22) An individual designated by the Coalition for Patients' Rights.

18 (23) An individual designated by Evidence in Motion.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee seek from Healthcare
20 Providers Service Organization liability and malpractice information and data
21 obtained from states with limited physical therapy patient access, states with less
22 restrictive physical therapy patient access, and states with unrestrictive physical
23 therapy patient access for comparative analysis."
