Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 156 by Senator Martiny

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 and insert the  
3 following:

4 **"A. On and after December 1, 2015, an applicant shall not be required to take**  
5 **the examination in the fundamental engineering subjects if he meets all of the**  
6 **following requirements:**

7 **(1) Holds an engineering degree. The board shall by rule set forth the types of**  
8 **approved or recognized engineering degrees.**

9 **(2) Possesses qualifying engineering work experience. The board shall by rule**  
10 **set forth the type and minimum number of years of qualifying engineering work**  
11 **experience and, based upon the level of engineering degree held by the**  
12 **applicant, the requisite work experience required under this Paragraph.**

13 **(3) Has successfully completed the principles and practice of engineering**  
14 **examination.**

15 **(4) Holds an active license to engage in the practice of engineering issued to him**  
16 **by proper authority of state, territory, or possession of the United States, or the**  
17 **District of Columbia, or within the past five years from the date of application**  
18 **has held an active license to engage in the practice of engineering issued to him**  
19 **by proper authority of state, territory, or possession of the United States, or the**  
20 **District of Columbia. The board shall by rule set forth the minimum years of**  
21 **engineering licensure in the other jurisdiction.**

23 **(5) Has no history of disciplinary action and no disciplinary proceeding**  
24 **pending against him by an engineering licensing authority of another state,**  
25 **territory, or possession of the United States, or the District of Columbia."**
