Present law requires members of boards and commissions to annually file a financial disclosure statement to the Board of Ethics.

Proposed law exempts members of boards and commissions who do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation or per diem from the financial disclosure filing requirement.

Proposed law exempts members of boards and commissions with expenditure authority of less than \$50,000 that do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation from the financial disclosure filing requirement.

Effective August 1, 2015.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to the original bill

1. Adds that members of boards and commissions must not be eligible to receive compensation or per diem to be exempt from the personal financial disclosure filing requirement.
2. Adds members of boards or commissions with expenditure authority of less than \$50,000 that do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation or per diem to those persons exempt from the personal financial disclosure filing requirement.
