11 On page 2, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

"§3139.6. Monitoring; reporting; renewal

13 (1) The Board of Regents annually shall monitor and report to the 14 legislature and the governor on each participating institution's progress in meeting the established targets for performance objectives as specified in 15 R.S. 17:3139.2 and the effect of the exemptions as provided in R.S. 16 17 17:3139.2(2)(a) and (4)(a) relative to the adoption of admission standards and the elimination of remedial education course offerings and 18 19 developmental study programs at certain institutions. At the end of the first 20 six years and each subsequent six-year period, the Board of Regents shall determine whether to recommend renewal of an institution's performance 21 22 agreement subject to the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the 23 Budget. Such determination shall be based on the recommendations of a 24 review panel established by the Board of Regents to conduct a 25 comprehensive review and evaluation of the institution's progress in meeting the performance objectives. The composition of the review panel shall be the 26 27 same as is provided in R.S. 17:3138(C) with the addition of two 28 representatives from the business community, who each possess a 29 postsecondary degree, one recommended by the speaker of the House of Representatives and one recommended by the president of the Senate. 30 *"

33 On page 2, at the end of line 16, add "The exceptions added to R.S. 17:3139.2(2)(a) and (4)(a) shall not apply to agreements entered into for the 2018-2019 academic year and 34 35 thereafter."
