

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to the original bill

1. Exempts an applicant for an engineering license from taking the fundamental engineering examination if he meets the following requirements:
 - (a) Holds an engineering degree.
 - (b) Possesses qualifying engineering work experience.
 - (c) Has passed the principles and practice of engineering examination.
 - (d) Holds an active engineering license or has held an active engineering license.
 - (e) Has no history of disciplinary action and no disciplinary proceeding pending against him by another engineering licensing authority.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Changes effective date of exemption for certain applicants from taking the fundamental engineering examination from December 1, 2015 to January 1, 2016.
2. Clarifies types of degrees.
3. Changes effective date of requirement for board to adopt rules to implement provisions of proposed law from December 1, 2015, to January 1, 2016.
