Abstract: Provides for delineation of the line between state ownership and private ownership of the lands adjacent to False River in Pointe Coupee Parish.

Present law specifies that title of the owners of land adjacent to False River in Pointe Coupee Parish extends to 15 feet above mean sea level and that the boundary line formed at 15 feet above mean sea level marks the division of the land owned by the state and the land owned by private landowners along the banks of the water body.

Proposed law changes that dividing line to a line delineated by an official survey completed in May, 2015, as approved by the State Land Office and submitted to the False River Watershed Council.
